

- 19. **STOP/REC:** In USB/CD, when press this key first time, the player will stop playing. And press PLAY/PAUSE key will continue to play from current music. When press this key again, the player will enter stop state. And press PLAY/PAUSE key will start from first song. In PHONO mode, press to start/stop recording of music playing from record to USB device. To delete the recorded track, hold button during it is playing (Note: The record function cannot work in the Bluetooth Out status).



REMOTE CONTROL

- 1. POWER
- 2. **MODE:** Press to change the mode
- 3. **REPEAT:** In CD/USB mode, press once to repeat current song. Press twice to repeat entire disc. Press three times to cancel.
- 4. MUTE
- 5. PLAY/PAUSE: Press to play/pause current track (USB/CD/Bluetooth) or search for stations (Radio).Press to mute the sound (LINE IN). In PHONO mode, hold to pair/unpair with external Bluetooth® devices.
- 6. **PREVIOUS/NEXT:** Press for previous/next track (USB/CD/Bluetooth) or previous/next station (Radio).
- 7. **VOLUME KEYS:** Press to turn the volume up/down.
- 8. **STOP/REC:** In USB/CD, when press this key first time, the player will stop playing. And press PLAY/PAUSE key will continue to play from current music. When press this key again, the player will enter stop state. And press PLAY/PAUSE key will start from first song. In PHONO mode, press to start/stop recording of music playing from record to USB device. To delete the recorded track, hold button during it is playing (Note: The record function cannot work in Bluetooth Out Status).
- 9. **NUMBER KEYS:** In USB/CD-MP3 mode, use the keys to select a track. In CD mode, to select tracks 1-9, press the corresponding number key (1-9). To select double digit tracks press the (10+) key followed by the corresponding number keys (1-9). For example, to select track 15, press the (10+) key once then the 5 key. To select track 25, press number key (10+) twice and then the 5 key.



Battery Precautions

- Be sure to insert the battery with correct positive + and negative polarities.
- When the remote-control unit is not to be used for long periods of time (more than a month), remove the battery from the remote-control unit to prevent it from leaking. If it leaks, carefully wipe away the liquid inside the battery compartment and replace the battery with a new one.
- Do not heat or disassemble batteries and never dispose of old batteries by throwing them into a fire.
- Do not mix old and new batteries.
- Use only the same type of batteries.
- Do not dispose of the batteries in fire, battery may explode or leak.
- Do not recharge a non-rechargeable battery.

SETUP & BASIC OPERATION

Essential Setup

- 1. Install the legs to the brackets on the bottom of the unit. Make sure the unit stands firmly.
- 2. Place the speakers on a flat and level surface. The selected location should be stable and free from vibration.
- **3.** Plug the power cord into the back of the unit.
- **4.** Plug the unit into the electrical outlet.

CONNECTING TO BLUETOOTH®

External devices that have a built-in Bluetooth® feature can connect wirelessly to the VWRP-3500.

Getting Connected

- 1. The first time you use your Bluetooth device with this player, you will need to connect or "pair" it with the player first.
- 2. Switch to the Bluetooth® mode, then use Bluetooth® device to pair with the device named "VICTOR VWRP-3500."
- 3. There will be a prompt sound after the successful pairing.
- 4. If the pairing device is disconnected, the unit will also issue a prompt sound.

Bluetooth Out

In PHONO mode, the unit can transmit sound from the record player to external Bluetooth® speaker/headphones.

- 1. In PHONO mode, hold the ►II/BT Out key on the unit or PLAY/PAUSE key on the remote to enter Bluetooth® pairing status. The Bluetooth symbol in the display will be flashing.
- 2. Turn on the external Bluetooth® device and entering the pairing mode.
- 3. The turntable unit and external Bluetooth® receiver will connect automatically. This process can take up to approx. 30-45 seconds. (Note: Place the Bluetooth® receiver device within 1m of the unit to connect properly.)
- 4. Once turntable unit is successfully connected with the external Bluetooth® speakers, you will hear a short confirmation sound from the speakers. The Bluetooth symbol in the display will be solid.
- 5. If want to turn off BT Out function, hold the ►II/BT Out key on the unit or PLAY/PAUSE key on the remote again, the Bluetooth® connection between unit and Bluetooth® receivers will be disconnected.

Note: "Bluetooth Out" only works with record playback. "Bluetooth Out" cannot work in Bluetooth IN/LINE IN/USB/CD/FM function mode.

USING THE CD PLAYER

Using the CD Player

- Press mode button to enter CD mode.
- 2. Press the button to open the CD door.
- 3. Place a CD in the disc tray with the label facing up and press the button to close the CD door.
- 4. Use the controls on the unit or the remote to begin playing the loaded disc.

USING THE FM RADIO

When you switch the unit to the radio mode, you can listen to the FM radio stations.

- 1. This radio antenna is on the back of the machine. When you need to listen to radio, please extend the FM antenna.
- 2. In FM mode, press the ►II/BT OUT on the unit or ►II button on the remote control to automatically search for a station. It will save the stations once searching completed.
- 3. Press the or on the unit or remote control to select station.

PLAYING FROM A USB DRIVE

You can play music from a USB drive on the unit through the built-in speakers.

- 1. Connect your USB drive (not included) to the USB port on the back of the unit.
- 2. Use the controls on the unit or remote-control to begin playing music on the USB drive.

Recording a Record to USB Drive

You can record the music playing music from a Phono record onto the USB drive.

- 1. Insert a USB drive to the USB port during the PHONO mode.
- 2. Press the **STOP/REC** key on the unit or remote during the Phono record is playing.
- 3. Press **STOP/REC** key again to stop the recording and replay the recorded track.
- 4. To delete the recorded track, press and hold the **STOP/REC** key during playback.

PLAYING A RECORD IN PHONO MODE

- 1. Press the mode button into PHONO mode.
- 2. Select the desired speed (33-1/3, 45, 78) and place the record on the turntable. (Note: When playing a 45 RPM record, please use the 45 RPM adapter.)
- 3. Remove the stylus protector from the stylus.

- 4. Release the tone arm from the tone arm clip.
- 5. Use the tonearm lever to raise the tonearm. Move the tonearm gently to desired position over the record.
- 6. Push the lift lever again to descend the tonearm slowly onto the desired position on the record to start playing.
- 7. When the record is finished playback, push the tonearm lever again to lift the tonearm and return the tonearm to the arm rest. Use the tonearm lever to descend the tonearm.

Note:

- When the Auto stop switch is "ON", the record will stop automatically when finished. When the Auto stop switch is "OFF", the record will not stop automatically when finished.
- Do not touch the stylus tip by fingers.

PLAYING AN EXTERNAL DEVICE

Line In Operation

You can play music from an external device on the built-in speakers by connecting a device to the Line In jack on the back of the unit.

- 1. Switch to **LINE IN** mode
- 2. Use 3.5mm audio cable (not included) to connect player with other audio output devices (such as mobile phone, computer, etc).

Audio Out Operation

You can connect the unit to an external stereo or speaker system by connecting a device to the AUX output jack on the back of the unit.

- 1. Connect the cable (not included) to the 3.5mm AUX Output jack on the back of the unit.
- 2. Connect the other end of the cable to the input on your external stereo system.
- 3. Use the device in your desired mode to hear audio on your external stereo system.

Note: The Audio output jack is not meant to be connected directly to passive/unpowered speakers. Connect to active (self-powered) speakers or an amplified stereo system.

TROUBLESHOOTING GUIDE

In case of trouble with the unit, please look through the problems below and see if you can solve them yourself before calling your dealer.

Problem	Solution
There is no power	Power cord is not properly connected.No power at the power outlet.
There is no sound from the speakers	 Check the unit connection between the mobile phone or other audio output devices. Adjust the volume.
The speakers could not be connected to my Bluetooth device	 The device's Bluetooth function is not turned on. The speakers are actively connected to another Bluetooth device.
The turntable speaker stop before the record is finished.	Adjust the Auto-stop switch to "OFF" position.
In "Bluetooth Out" function, the unit and Bluetooth receiver do not connect successfully	 Turn the unit and Bluetooth receiver off. Follow the pairing steps again from the beginning. Check whether the turntable unit is connected with another Bluetooth receiver.
Don't play disc	 Check whether the disc is put inserted correctly. To check whether there is a disc in the tray. The disc is dirty. Please clean the disc.
Button does not work	Turn off the power and turn it on again after 10 seconds.
